

Building the Foundation

Students' ability to read on grade level with high levels of thinking does not happen by chance. Through this series of modules, participants will learn how to build a solid literacy foundation that includes the five components of reading. The modules will begin with phonological awareness, the best early indicator for reading success at third grade, and will build up to the highest level of comprehension (Figure 19), making inferences.
